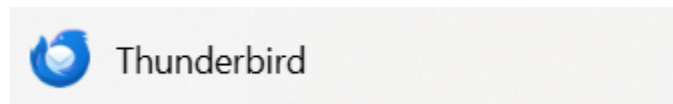


# How to Set Up Your IMAP Email Address in Thunderbird for Windows *Version 152.0 (64-bit)*

## Setup Thunderbird for PC for the first time

1. Open “Thunderbird” on your PC.



2. Enter the following information.

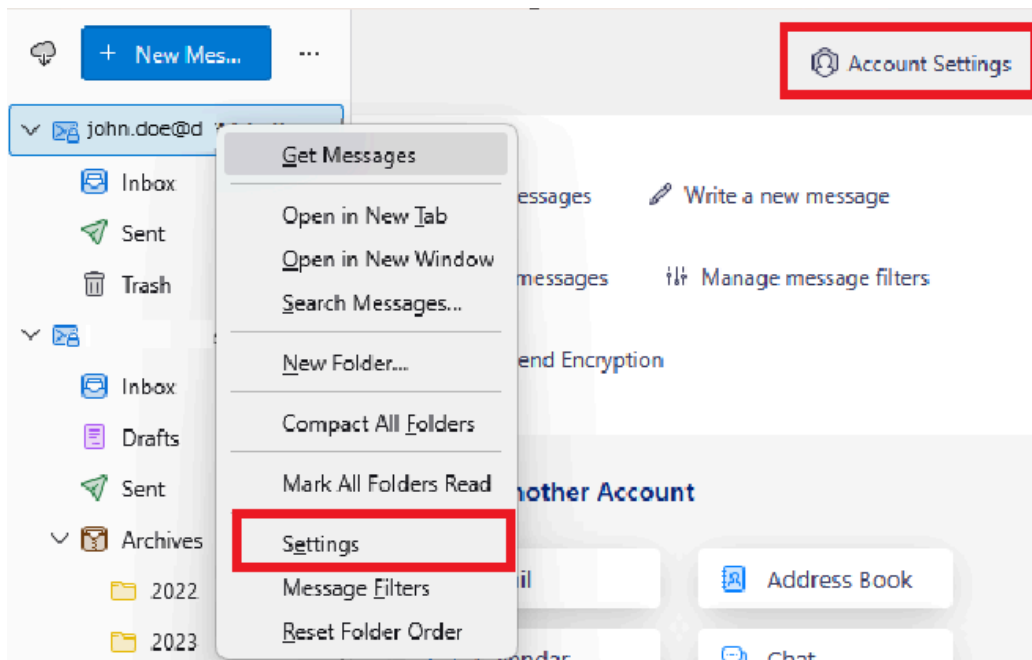

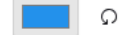
